St. Joseph altars, representing the Holy Trinity, are usually divided into three sections with a statue of St. Joseph at the center. The devout place candles, figurines, flowers, medals, and other items around the altar creating a beautiful, lush, and overflowing effect.

Since the altars thank St. Joseph for relieving hunger, offerings of food are essential. We would like to invite families to send in food on the morning of His feast day. The children will be invited to have a treat after their lunch.

Items we are requesting for the altar include the following: figurines, small statues, pictures, medals and candles. **PLEASE LABEL** the items you send so they may be returned promptly. We will try to secure everything, but please don't send anything irreplaceable with your children.
