- Floor scrapers
- Baby supplies (diapers, wipes, formula, baby food, car seats)
- Towels
- Cases of bottled water
- Floor fans
- Old newspapers for packing
- Cases of paper towels
- Cases of toilet paper
- Cases of sanitizing wipes
- Battery powered camping lanterns
- Power strips
- Pop up tables to place and stage stuff
- Step ladders
- Drop cloths
- Hammers, blade utility knives
- Sharpees of different sizes and colors
- Good first aid kit (many cuts and scrapes during clean up)
- Rolls of duct tape and packing tape
- Hand sanitizer
- Gently used clothes & toys
