

# JPG SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS

## *Lower School*

### Pre-K

- 1 container baby wipes
- 1 container Clorox Wipes
- hand sanitizer
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of facial tissue
- 1 pack of construction paper
- 3 .77 oz. Elmer's Glue Sticks (purple tinted ones are nice but not required)
- 2 (4 oz.) bottles Elmer's Glue
- 1 box washable Crayola Classic Markers (thick)
- 2 boxes Crayola Crayons (24 count)
- 1 pair Fiskar Scissors (blunt tip)
- 1 plastic pencil/color box
- 1 pack of standard size Play-Doh brand play-dough (4 per pack)

- backpack or small tote bag (big enough to fit a folder and blanket, can be any color, no characters, no wheels)
- Kinder Mat (red and blue nap mat with 4 sections- Walmart carries them)
- cover for nap time (small blanket or small towel)
- travel pillow and "lovey" for nap time (if desired)
- change of underwear and socks in a labeled zip-lock (I have extra uniforms that can be returned the following day.)

Girls:

- 1 box gallon zip-lock bags

Boys:

- 1 box quart zip-lock bags

## Kindergarten

- 1 Change of undergarments and socks in labeled gallon ziplock ( I have extra uniforms that can be returned the following day)
- 1 Nap Mat – red/blue, 4 fold (Walmart is almost \$10 now, but Fred’s or Dollar Store are cheaper. As long as the dimensions are the same, it’s fine.)
- 1 Black/White Marble PRIMARY K-2<sup>nd</sup> Composition Book/Journal (no wire edge, the pages of this tablet are **divided – top is blank for illustrations, bottom is lined for writing**)
- 1 Pack of glue sticks (3)
- 1 flip-top pencil box (basic blue, pink, green – available at most stores) no zipper bags
- 2 24 pack Crayola Crayons (Crayola is a tad more expensive, but the cheapies break very easily.)
- 1 4-pack of Playdough
- 2 Rolls of Paper Towels
- 1 Container of Baby Wipes (used on skin, can be small pack)
- 1 Coloring Book (for rainy recess)
- 2 Pencil Top Erasers
- 2 Packs of Flashcards (numbers and letters) for home
- 1 Booksack large enough for a folder (no Disney or superhero designs, no rolling booksacks)
- 1 Lunch bag (with an ice pack for keeping food cool)

Girls:

- 2 Pack of Gallon Ziplocs

Boys:

- 1 Pack of Quart Ziplocs

\*A desk seat pack is optional. These can be any color and monogrammed if you wish.

Nap Supplies: Each student has a 1’ cubby for change of clothes and nap things. Your child can bring a small blanket (or beach towels work well), a travel pillow, or some sort of “lovey” to keep in their cubby. In this case, smaller is better. After a long day at school, they’d sleep on anything! These items will be sent home every Friday for washing.

Lots of these items can be purchased at Dollar Tree, so you may want to start there. Some locations even have the Primary Journals with the blank top/lined bottom, and that would be just fine, too.
