To the JPG Family,

As we prepare for our departure to the national March for Life next week, I am reminded of what a great gift it is to help form our JPG students as citizens of both this world and the next.

Even amidst the exorable movement towards a post-Christian America and what Pope St. John Paul the Great called the "culture of death," we see at the same time great signs of hope at the March for Life. Each year, the crowd seems to be bigger, with more and more young families, more college students, more young priests, more seminarians and religious, and without question, more high school students!

Attending our local March for Life will also offer encouragement to Bishop Deshotel, who has courageously chosen to be a visible and vocal pro-life leader in Acadiana. May God grant us safe travel to and from our nation's capital, and may He continue to guide us to be faithful witnesses to the dignity of every life.

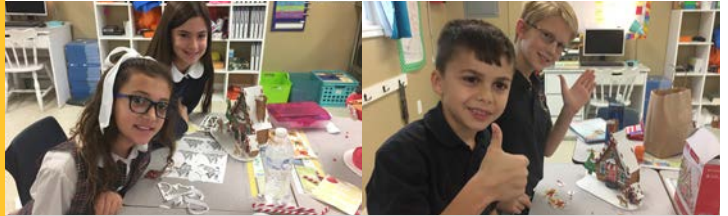
